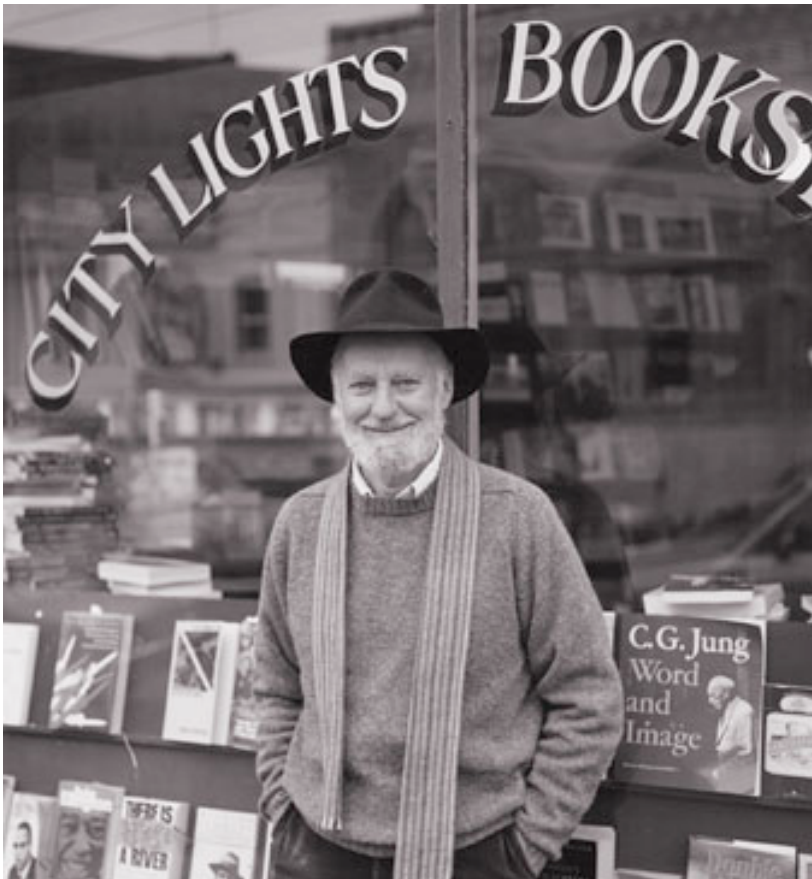

The following figure is taken from an actual published scientific article showing the infrared emission from zodiacal dust in our Solar System. Look carefully at the y-axes. They say “Flux” but the units are **NOT** flux. What should the y-axis labels read assuming those units are correct?
